Templeton Family Farms is seeking individuals to help with crop harvest 2011. Harvest begins in early September and will last until mid to late November. All hours and shifts are available from 5 am to 11 pm., 7 days a week weather permitting. Minimum working time for a shift is 4 hours. Normal shifts run from 6am to 3pm and from 2pm to 10pm. This is a local harvest covering a 4 county area in West Central Iowa.

Tasks can include but not limited to; Fuel/lube machines, operate grain carts in the field capturing grain from the combine and then transport/fill to truck, operate combines, trucks hauling grain and fertilizer, tillage units, shuttle fertilizer, apply fertilizer, and maintain/clean equipment.

Equipment is all late model John Deere tractors, combines, Peterbilt Semi's, and J&M grain carts. The fleet is 100% equipped with GPS AutoSteer for repetitive tasks. The fleet is meticulously cared for and kept as clean as possible, inside and out. Operators are expected to maintain a safe and clean working environment. No smoking is allowed while operating the equipment.

Equipment **drivers** can seek employment elsewhere!

We are in need of skilled and intelligent **operators** that will care and respect what they are operating and also understand how to make it perform to its full potential. We need alert and self-motivated operators that are willing to work in a fast paced environment. An alert operator does not attend to social media while driving, they attend to the multi-thousand dollar machine they are operating and the task they are performing. There is a time and place for social media and it is not while capturing grain from a combine while traveling 5 mph, all while only inches from the cutting platform.
